Who: Residents only, proof of
residency required

How do I transport materials?

Bring materials in original containers
securely closed.

Pack containers in sturdy upright boxes
and pad with newspaper if necessary.

Leaking or broken containers must be
contained.

Never smoke or eat while handling
hazardous materials.

Never mix chemicals together!

**Please! Do not leave your vehicle unless
instructed to do so.**

What to Bring

Household hazardous waste no longer
needed. Limited to 5 gallons or 50 pounds
per household.

Examples:

Oil or oil based paints and strippers
Paint thinner, solvents
Stains and varnishes
Solvent adhesives
Lighter fluid
Waste fuels: kerosene and gasoline
Antifreeze
Engine degreaser, carburetor cleaner
Brake fluid, transmission fluid
Pesticides, insecticides, weed killer
Moth balls, flea powder
Resins, adhesives
Rubber cement, airplane glue
Hobby supplies, art supplies
Photo chemicals, chemistry sets
Furniture, floor and metal polish
Oven and toilet cleaners
Drain cleaners
Rug and Upholstery cleaner
Dry cleaning solvents, spot removers
Aerosol cans
Pool chemicals
Automobile and truck batteries
LP gas cylinders (grill size only) **\$5 each**

Used motor oil

What not to bring!

LATEX PAINT OR PRODUCTS
(limited supply of latex paint hardener available
at collection)

Latex driveway sealer

Tires

Radioactive waste

Ammunition, fireworks, explosives

Infectious and biological waste

Prescription drugs, syringes

Penta brand wood preservatives

Pesticides with 2,4,5-T, Silvex

Commercial or industrial waste

Non-rechargeable household batteries

Fluorescent bulbs
