The Southeast Regional Recycling Partnership (SERRP) is a work group of municipal officials from the Towns of Foxborough, Mansfield, North Attleborough, Plainville, and Wrentham. This regional group has identified the need of small businesses to have access to cost-effective recycling options for paper and cardboard generated in the workplace. Because recycling of cardboard and paper is beneficial to the environment (saving trees, water, and energy) and meets one of the state's waste ban requirements, the SERRP developed this business recycling program to serve you, our local businesses.
