

Planning Board SRPEDD Representative

The Commission of the Southeastern Regional Planning and Economic Development District (SRPEDD) includes the chief elected officials (mayors and boards of selectmen) in SRPEDD's 27 cities and towns (or their appointee); the region's 27 planning boards (or their appointee); and up to six at large slots representative of low income and minority group interests.

The volunteer Commissioners govern the agency as a board of directors, setting policy, establishing priorities and representing their communities in regional deliberations. The commission has administrative responsibilities including electing officers, adopting the budget, appointing committees, employing the executive director and establishing the policies for employment of the staff.
