



## Notice Leonard Street & Leonard Circle Road Improvements

The DPW-Highway Division has scheduled Leonard Street and Leonard Circle for road improvements this construction season.

The plans are to remove and replace a deteriorated sewer manhole, remove the existing curb and replace with new curbing, repair sidewalks as needed and overlay, full depth repairs where needed and then rubber chip seal followed by a 1-1/2 inch overlay.

- Starting on or about May 29, 2019 the Highway Division will start removing all of the existing curb and part of the grass strip.
- This is will be followed by the installation of granite curbing on corners and the cul-desac to minimize future plow damage. All other areas will have new monolithic Cape Cod berm installed with the paving in July.
- Additional updates will be provided once we have tentative dates for the chip sealing and final paving.
- If anyone has irrigation in the grass strip, please mark and/or remove so it does not get damaged.

Please be aware that upon final paving, the road will have a five (5) year "no dig" moratorium.

If anyone is considering adding or upgrading water, sewer or gas services, please schedule it with the appropriate utility and also notify the DPW.
