To Whom It May Concern,

This notification is to make you aware of an event to be held at Fulton Pond on the night of October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019 as well as the afternoon of October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019. It is our intent to minimize the impact as much as possible for our Town residents who abut this area.

As you may be aware, this event includes different types of activities that will be located on Town Property and Public Greenways. These activities include on Friday evening from 6:30PM to 8:30pm, a Beer Garden for Saturday Afternoon, a craft sale, food vendors, face painting, Llama petting, Ferris wheel, and other small children's activities and games. All activities, except for the Beer Garden and Food Vendors, are free. The Ferris wheel, Beer Garden, and Llama petting will be fenced in and access will be restricted. Please find the attached maps that highlight where the activities will be located for both evenings.

The event will have music contained to the Fulton Pond area in accordance with local noise laws. On Friday evening, there will be a local drummer group that will not be using any speaker systems. On Saturday afternoon there will be two bands. The first band will be performing between 12:00PM and 2:00PM and a second band will perform between 2:00PM and 5:00PM. We will have staff on hand to address any noise concerns.

It is important to note that Rumford Avenue will be closed from the intersection of Villa Street to West Street on Friday 10/4 between the hours of 5:00PM & 9:30PM and again on Saturday 10/5 from the hours of 9:30AM & 6:00PM. Due to this inconvenience we have made residential access a priority. For those residents who live between Villa Street and the Copeland House, you will be given access via a police detail at the intersection of Villa Street to your property via placards that will be given to you in advance and we ask that you place them on the dashboard of your vehicle/s. For the limited number of residents who live between West Street and the Copeland House, we will be making arrangements for you to have your own reserved parking with unrestricted access at the Congregational Church nearby your property.

The Town of Mansfield's Public Safety Departments will be present throughout the entire event to ensure the safety and security Police officers will also be present at key locations to assist with traffic flow as well as pedestrian crossing.
