PRESS RELEASE

The Mansfield Police Department is conducting an investigation involving the **Breaking & Entering of an occupied home on Stearns Avenue early this morning, 12/17/19 at approximately 3:10 am.** The suspects were able to gain access with a set of house keys left in the homeowner's unlocked vehicle. The sleeping homeowners and their guests were not awakened by two men who were able to steal items during the brief period that they were inside the home.

Please have a look at the suspects and their four-door silver sedan gathered from a surveillance camera inside the home, a convenience store they visited, and other surveillance gathered as they drove through town. We are asking that our residents, especially in the Stearns Ave area, look around their homes and vehicles to determine if there were any additional crimes committed.

Suspect #1: described as a white male approximately 5' 10 possibly mid 40's with blonde hair and an average build. He was wearing a dark-colored jacket with a hood, a light-colored shirt underneath, dark pants and white sneakers with black trim on the bottom. Video shows a scroll or tribal type tattoo on his inner left wrist possibly extending upward on the underside of his forearm.

Suspect #2: The second suspect is a black male approximately 6' mid 30's, slight facial hair, wearing a dark-colored hooded jacket with buttons, dark pants, a dark stocking-type hat and dark sneakers with white trim on the bottom.

We would like to thank our community members who have stepped up to help us in gathering additional information on these two criminals. We are asking for the public's help in identifying them. Please call 508-261-7300 (press option 8) and speak to our front desk personnel to provide any additional information that will help us close this case. We would also like to remind our residents and visitors to lock your vehicles at all times and to never leave valuables inside.
