
On 5/10/2020 at approximately 2:30 pm, the Mansfield Police department responded to a 911 call from a party reporting an ongoing disturbance and threatening situation at 606 School Street Mansfield.

Upon arrival, officers were met by the reporting party who stated that a subject inside the house had been making threatening statements involving a firearm and acting in a threatening manner. Officers determined that no one else was inside the home, moved the reporting party to a safe distance, assumed safe positions around the home to contain any potential threats, and shut off the road on School Street to minimize potential danger to anyone passing by. When it was safe to do so, they then made contact with the individual via phone and loudspeaker. The individual then surrendered himself to police at that time and was taken into custody.

Based off of further evidence obtained during the investigation, officers then froze the scene and obtained a search warrant for the property. Shortly after obtaining the warrant, members of the Mansfield Police Department Detectives unit, along with members of the Metropolitan Law Enforcement Council (MetroLEC), Massachusetts state Police, and the Bureau of ATF (Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms) executed the court-authorized search of 606 School Street.

As a result of the search of the premises, a number of firearms, rifles, ammunition, a bullet proof vest, and suspected narcotics were removed. The subject, Trevor Johnstun, age 28 of 606 School Street is being held on bail, and will be charged with the following:

1. Possession Class A drugs
2. Possession of ammunition without an FID card
3. Possession of a firearm without an FID card
4. Possession of a firearm with defaced serial numbers
5. Improper storage of a firearm
6. Possession of a machine gun
7. Possession with intent to distribute counterfeit substance
8. Possession of ammunition without an FID card
9. Possession of ammunition without an FID
10. Possession class E drugs
