COMMUNITY UPDATE COVID-19

June 19, 2020:

The Town of Mansfield continues its community update on our website Monday-Friday with our up to date information and important tips for the public as it relates to the COVID-19 pandemic. For more complete information, please see the town [coronavirus webpage](#).

- **Reopening Massachusetts: Step 2 Phase II**

Today, the Baker-Polito Administration announced that Step Two of Phase II of the Commonwealth's four-phase reopening plan, [Reopening Massachusetts](#), will begin on Monday, June 22 to allow additional industries to resume operations under sector-specific guidelines.

On May 18, the Administration [released](#) a four-phased plan to reopen the economy based on public health data, spending at least three weeks in each phase. Key public health data, such as new cases and hospitalizations, has been closely monitored and seen a significant decline allowing for Step Two of Phase II to begin on June 22.

Businesses and sectors set to begin operating in Step Two of Phase II are subject to compliance with all mandatory safety standards.

The following businesses will be eligible to reopen in Step Two of Phase II on Monday, June 22:

- Indoor table service at restaurants
- Close-contact personal services, with restrictions. Close Contact Personal Services are defined as any personal service typically delivered through close physical contact with the customer, including but not limited to:
 - hair removal services;
 - massage, body treatments, eastern treatment, energy therapies and other body work therapies;
 - skin care services; including peels, facials, serums, Botox and filler
 - nail care services; including nail salons
 - other hair services; including hair replacement services, scalp treating services
 - makeup salons;
 - makeup application services;
 - personal trainers; provided that in Phase 2 any indoor personal training service is limited to appointment-only training with only one customer (or two from the same household) allowed in the facility at a time;
 - tanning salons; including other businesses
- Retail dressing rooms, by appointment only;
- Offices, at 50 percent capacity
