- **Mansfield Community Designation Level**

The Commonwealth is reporting enhanced [community-level data on key COVID-19 metrics](#) as part of the Baker-Polito Administration's efforts to partner with cities and towns to slow the spread of the virus. This information is updated every Wednesday in the [COVID-19 Weekly Public Health Report](#).

Based on the average daily cases per 100,000 residents, each city or town has been designated as a higher risk (red), moderate risk (yellow), or lower risk (green) community. Communities with fewer than 5 cases are not given a designation. Each community can be clicked to see key COVID-19 statistics.

As of Wednesday, August 19, 2020, Mansfield was designated as moderate risk (yellow) community. A total of 15 positive tests within the past 2 weeks translated to an average daily incidence rate of 4.23 per 100,000 people.

Residents are reminded to continue actions to prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- Wash your hands often
- Avoid close contact
- Cover your mouth and nose with a mask when around others
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily
- Monitor your health daily
