





The VaxMillions Giveaway will consist of five weekly statewide drawings with participants being eligible to win one of the prizes below:


- Massachusetts residents 18 years of age and older who have received both doses of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines or one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine will have a chance to win one of five \$1 million cash prizes.
- Massachusetts residents between 12 and 17 years of age who have received both doses of the Pfizer vaccine will have a chance to win one of five \$300,000 scholarship grants to a 529 College Savings Plan managed by the Massachusetts Educational Financing

Authority (MEFA). Funds in a 529 plan can be applied to cover tuition, room and board, and related expenses at any college, university, technical or trade school, or other post-secondary educational institution eligible to participate in a student aid program administered by the U.S. Department of Education. Winners with a qualifying disability may elect instead to receive an equivalent financial contribution to a special needs trust or federally qualified ABLE account to cover qualified expenses.

The Commonwealth is launching the Massachusetts VaxMillions giveaway as one of many strategies to increase awareness of the availability and efficacy of the COVID-19 vaccines and to encourage residents to get vaccinated and to be safe.

You must be fully vaccinated prior to submitting your entry. This means you must have received two doses of either the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, or one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine.

Residents will be able to enter the VaxMillions Giveaway online and additional details on the website sign up will be released prior to July 1.
