

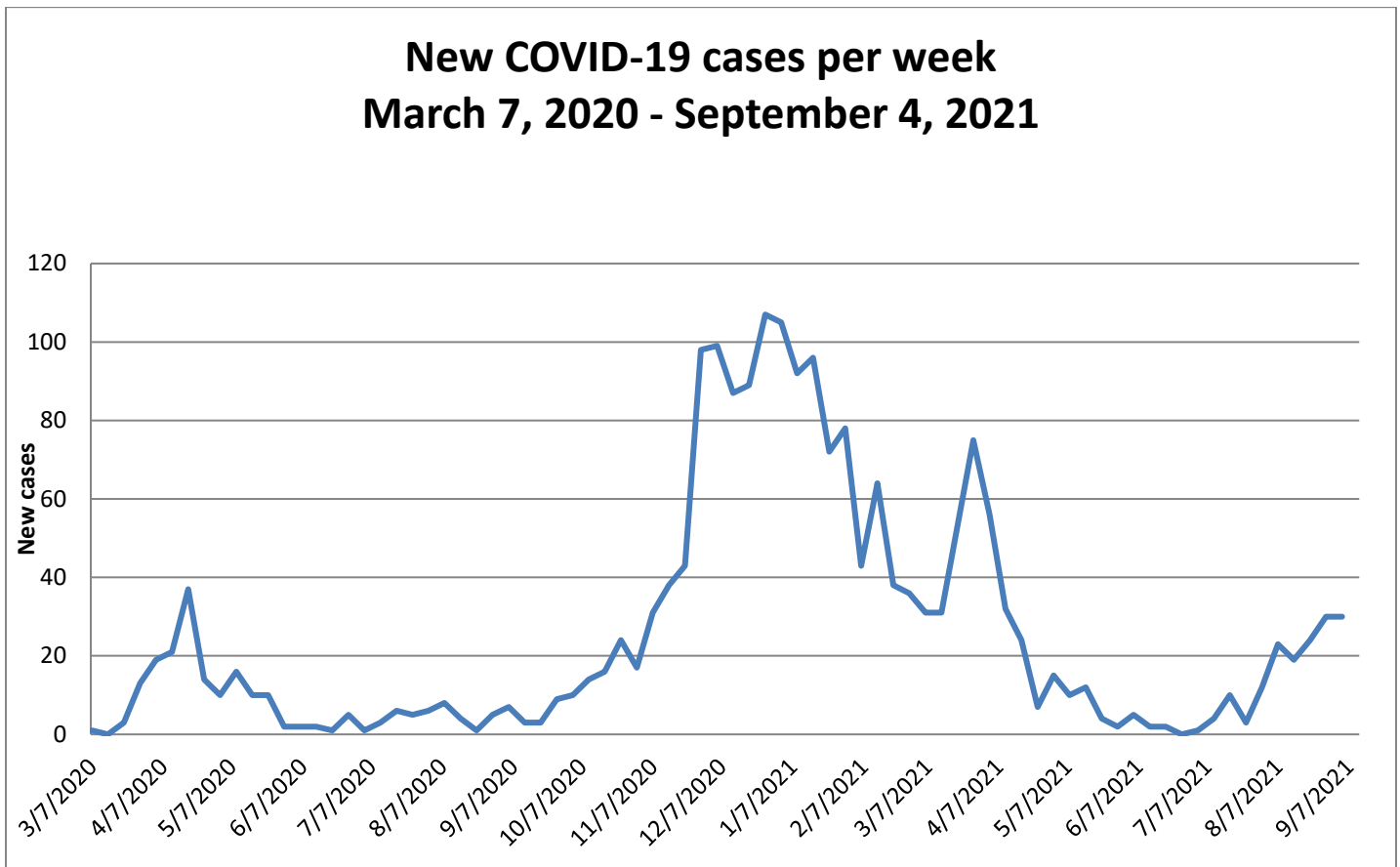
## COMMUNITY UPDATE COVID-19

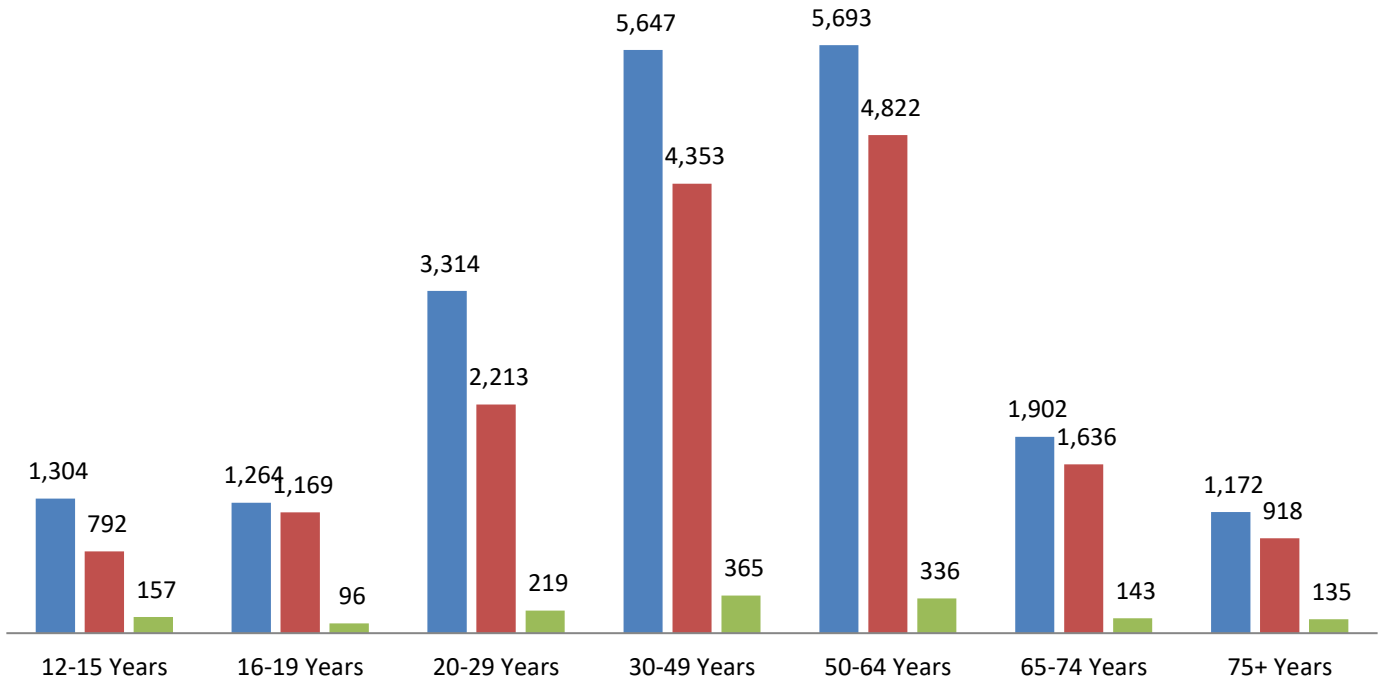

## U.S. COVID-19 Vaccination Progress

People who have received at least one dose of any vaccine:  
**207.6 MILLION**

People fully vaccinated with a single-dose vaccine:  
**14.3 MILLION**

People fully vaccinated with a two-dose vaccine:  
**162.3 MILLION**

People fully vaccinated:  
**176.6 MILLION**

Percentage of people who received at least one dose: **62.5%**

Percentage of people who are fully vaccinated: **53.2%**

As of September 7, 2021, 207.6 million people, or about 62.5% of the U.S. population, have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. Of those, 176.6 million, or about 53.2% of the population, are fully vaccinated.

**People age 12+ who live, work or study in Massachusetts can be vaccinated.**

# Symptoms of Coronavirus (COVID-19)

**Know the symptoms of COVID-19, which can include the following:**



Symptoms can range from mild to severe illness, and appear 2–14 days after you are exposed to the virus that causes COVID-19.

**Seek medical care immediately if someone has  
Emergency Warning Signs of COVID-19**

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Pale, gray, or blue-colored skin, lips, or nail beds, depending on skin tone

This list is not all possible symptoms. Please call your healthcare provider for any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to you.

Bristol County has been identified by the CDC as an area of high transmission for COVID-19. The CDC recommends all people, no matter their vaccination status, wear masks indoors and in crowded outdoor settings in areas of substantial or high transmission.
