Press Release

At approximately 7:49 pm on Sunday, September 3, Dispatchers from the Southeastern Massachusetts Regional Emergency Communications Center began receiving 911 calls reporting a severe motor vehicle crash at the intersection of Tremont and Williams Streets. First responding officers confirmed a single vehicle roll-over crash with the driver and sole occupant suffering from what appeared to be significant injuries.

Mansfield Fire arrived with two ambulances and two engine companies. They found the lone occupant of the vehicle had then self-extricated. Upon evaluation, the injuries were severe enough that the decision was made to activate Boston Medflight to transport the patient via helicopter. At the time of transport, the patient had serious, life-threatening injuries. We do not have an update on the patient's condition.

The road was reopened at approximately 4:00 am after an investigation by Mansfield Detectives and Collision Reconstructionist Officer David Kinahan. Preliminary investigation indicated the vehicle, a 2019 Ford Ranger pick-up truck, was traveling at a high rate of speed southbound on Tremont and failed to stop at the stop sign at Williams St. The vehicle struck a telephone pole and rolled several times before coming to rest upside down against a garage. No one at the property was injured.

The crash remains under investigation by Officer David Kinahan and Detective David Kerr.
