PRESS RELEASE

At approximately 3:41 am this morning, Sunday, November 12, 2023, officers from the Mansfield Police Department responded to Fieldstone Drive following a 911 call to the Southeastern Massachusetts Regional Emergency Communications Center (SEMRECC). The caller reported observing home video surveillance of a person entering the caller's vehicle in the driveway. The subject ran off, but the caller alerted responding officers to a white SUV parked in the street. Arriving officers began to investigate and learned the involved suspicious vehicle was stolen out of Weymouth.

A short time later, a man appeared and accessed the vehicle. Officers detained the individual while additional officers, assisted by MSP and MPD K9 Ronan began pursuing the sounds of fleeing suspects into the wooded area near Fieldstone and Branch Streets. Three additional suspects were located in that area. One was taken into custody and the others fled deeper into the woods. At approximately 6:15 am, officers observed one of the suspects coming out of the woods on Ware St. just south of Kevin's Way. A foot pursuit ensued and the suspect was taken into custody behind the Jordan/Jackson School. A firearm discarded by the suspect was found in the wood line nearby. In custody and awaiting arraignment at Attleboro District Court on Monday on charges including nighttime B&E into a vehicle, receiving stolen property, conspiracy, and resisting arrest are three males aged 19, 21, and 22 from Brockton.

As residents woke up and began their Sunday mornings, additional calls came in reporting more breaking & entering into vehicles and stolen cars. As of this release, officers and detectives are investigating reports from residents in other areas of town. A thorough search of the area was conducted and one suspect, believed to have fled the area, remains unidentified. We are requesting any homeowners who may have captured the subjects on their home surveillance cameras.
